A Medieval Miscellany By Librarian Alexandria

Miscellany...

Digging through the rubble of last edition's chaos, your humble Librarian found some real miscellany.

Alfred the Great's family was sort of single-minded about names. His dad Aethelwulf named all of his kids with the beginning name "Aethel," which means "Noble." I.e., Aethelstan, Aethelbald, Aethelberht, Aethelred, and their sister Aethelswith. "Aelfred," which was the original of his name, means "Elf Counseled." He was a very sickly kid, so it might have been they thought he was a changeling, so he got a different style of name.



Emma of Normandy was the great-granddaughter of Rollo, first Duke of Normandy (the Viking that took over that part of France) and the great-aunt of William the Conqueror. She was also queen of England, Denmark, Norway, queen to two kings (Aethelred "the Unready," and his successor, Cnut), and mother of two kings (Harthacnut and Edward the Confessor). You probably never heard of her.



War horses were smaller than we think, probably averaging 14.5 - 15 hands.

They didn't become a major part of battles till about 1300. Prior to that, in pitched battles, knights usually dismounted. That went on until improvements in infantry weapons and armor evened the odds a bit.

Muslims preferred mares in battle.

Sidesaddles were invented in the 13th century but rarely used. Women rode astride until tech improvements to the sidesaddle in the late 18th century.

The name "Dracula" means "Son of the Dragon." Dracula's father belonged to a knighthood called the Dragons.

Dracula had a younger brother named Radu the Handsome.



Chimneys weren't invented until the 11th century. Fireplaces as we think of them didn't exist until then; they were just a hearth in the middle of the floor with a hole in the roof above them.



Spanish names like Hernandez, Rodriguez, Lopez, and Fernandez are descendants of Visigothic names, not Latin.



Claude, Ludovic, Clovis, Ludwig and Louis are all the same name.


