## Welcome to the first and maybe only edition of “This old Archer” - Or, how I became the Midlands Regional Champion

So I was thinking... this morning... on the way home from Baroness Wars XI and ToA (Midlands)...

We had a lot of fun on the archery range, which included the competition to become the Midlands Regional Champion, which I ultimately received after some discussion amongst the former Champion, Her Majesty (then Highness) Jalida al-Hasannah, and the other two top shooters: Reimar Erikson, and Dietrich von Hamburg. But more on that later.

The shoot was based on Skeeball - three targets of large to small circles at different ranges, just off the ground. Scoring was 1 point for the Big Circle (white), 2 for the Medium Circle (red), and 3 for the Small Circle (green). Three ends of six arrows each with a minimum score of 18 and a maximum of 54. So, I went into the shoot knowing the ‘Victory Conditions.’ I could see all the targets and I knew who I was shooting against. Now on to the shoot.

This is where I made my first mistake. The 3 point target was at about 20 yards on a hill at ground level and about the size of the 4 and 5 rings on a 60 cm target. You’re thinking, that sound good... that’s in the sweet spot... no problem... Yeah that’s what my ego was thinking, and that’s where I aimed. First arrow, missed. Second arrow, missed. Third arrow, also missed. Brain kicks in, throat punches my ego and I put one in the white target, so I get a point on the first pass. Ego is not necessarily out of the fight and thinks: two arrows at the red target, the 2 pointer that’s closer than the green but a little more back than the white. Both miss.

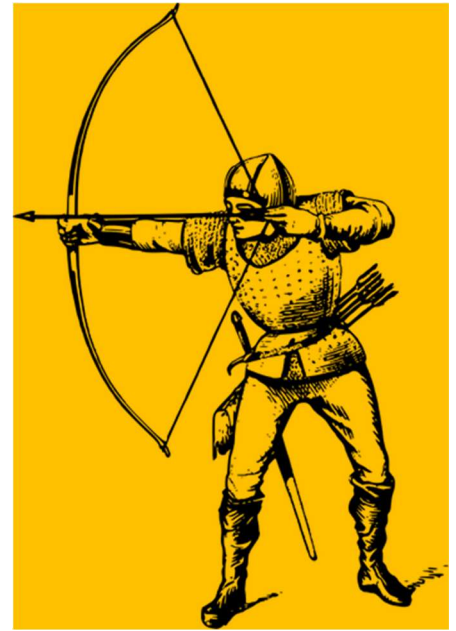
Then it gets worse, we retrieve our arrows and the scores so far. OK “Archers to the line...” I put two arrows into the white and the rest I shoot at the red (all missed). But I miscounted so I only shot 5 arrows. (WTH? ‘Wulf you rookie!). We go to get our arrows and scores. This dog is still in the hunt (I think), onto the third round.

Last Round, I’m not sure what the scores are but I know it’s close (this is also a mistake (damn they are adding up)). During the walk down and back to get arrows we speculated that Dietrich was playing his own game - get at least one arrow in each of the color targets. Also on the walk back I realized that I lost a tip on one of my arrows and I didn’t have spares handy, (another mistake). Back to the line, 3 arrows in the white, one in the red and one miss. Total score for the competition - 8.

Now to be fair Dietrich did beat me with a score of 9. Reimar scored 7. During the discussion afterward that I mentioned earlier, I believe someone said “tag you’re it” and now I’m the Regional Champion. Which is why I’m writing this (I hate writing). Remember what I said about the minimum score? If I, or anyone else that was shooting had put all of their arrows in the ‘safe bet’ white target, the biggest and closest target, they would have had a score of 18! The winning score was less than half! Any one of the other shooters on the line had a chance to win that shoot.

Now what is the point of all this, the lesson that can be learned? The main one is don’t let your ego make your choices for you. Should you push yourself for the harder targets? Well yes, absolutely. But remember what your goal is. Are you trying to win the competition? Risk over Reward has consequences. Other lessons include:

1. “Situational awareness” - if you are paying attention to the announced score, you know what you need to shoot to win.
2. Have extra kit on hand if you can-- I had even put extra arrows in my quiver that morning, but one broke and another was lost.



3. And after all that the last thing is *“Did you have FUN?”* Because really that’s what we are here for. It was a good day on the range, there was learning, joking, laughing, and hanging with friends.

# Ayreton Great Book Project

Greetings unto all,

Some time back, Their Excellencies talked of the possibility of a community project to create a document that would act as a repository for the history of the Barony, as well as a way to display the talents of its many artists. In short, the creation of a Great Book for Ayreton.

With the permission of Their Excellencies, I am acting as the coordinator for this effort. I spoke on this topic at a previous Baronial meeting, explaining the basics of the project, and requesting feedback, suggestions and volunteers.

The idea behind the Great Book is it's about the history and culture of our Barony. Possible content could include:

- ❖ A History of the Founding of the Barony of Ayreton.
- ❖ History of major events within our borders.
- ❖ Lists of officers, champions, etc.
- ❖ Songs and poems about the Barony.
- ❖ History of each of the cantons.
- ❖ Display of the awards of the Barony.

So, how can someone help? There are a number of roles for interested participants.

*Historians.* Do you have information about the founding of the Barony? Can you write about your canton? What about those who held positions, such as the Mayor of the proto-Barony? It's important to remember that Ayreton's history does not start with the founding of the Barony.

*Bards and Poets.* Some of this goes along with Historian, but also includes poetry and songs written about the Barony.

*Editors.* Volunteers are needed to review and edit submitted text, prior to someone enscripting the calligraphed page. All content should follow the SCA governing documents. The final arbiters for any editorial decisions include myself, and the Baron & Baroness.

*Calligraphers and Illuminators.* Since this is a book, there's a lot of opportunities on this front. Art styles are fairly wide open. Contact me for technical specifications, such as paper type, size, etc. No one is expected to do an entire page by themselves. If you enjoy illumination, but don't do much calligraphy, partner with someone who does. I can assist with finding someone.

*Artisans.* Calligraphy and illumination will take a leading role at the beginning, but as the Great Book progresses, other skills will be needed. Bookbinding is one obvious possibility, but others, such as metal, leather or wood working could be needed, to form the binding or a travel case.

*Other roles.* To be determined as needed.

Technical specifications:

- ❖ Paper is Strathmore Bristol, 11"x14", Smooth finish, 100lbs
- ❖ Margins should be minimum 1" for top, bottom and right, 2" for left
- ❖ Each page is single sided, on the versal (right) when book is open
- ❖ Ink is based on the calligrapher's preference.
- ❖ Pigment should be relatively-color fast and stable. Multiple brands are available, such as Holbein, Windsor Newton, and others. Please avoid dangerous pigments, such as orpiment (arsenic sulfide), cinnabar (mercury (II) sulfide), minium (lead tetroxide), cadmium yellow, etc.
- ❖ Styles are up to the artist.

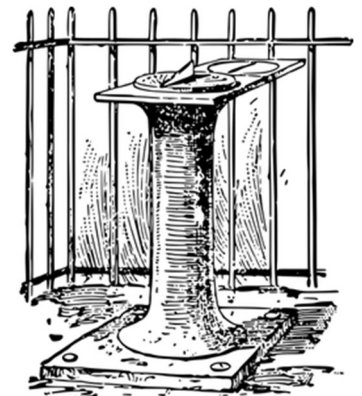
